Children in Worship at PHPC

Being with one another is how we learn to be a family. Worship is no different. Young people giggle, poke, ask questions, and swing their legs. Children learn about worship and how to participate by experience, by how they are welcomed into the community, and by what they see big people doing. We value the leadership and participation of all ages in worship, including children. We have several options for your family to choose from to help you engage in worship together. Choose what aligns with your values and works best with your family. Tell your child ahead of time about what's happening. Use the bulletin to show them where they will have an active role in the service and when they will listen or watch quietly.

Worshiping Together

The **Children's Sermon** is a time in worship each week designed to communicate the Bible stories and themes of the day. Children of all ages are invited to join the pastors on the front steps.

Worship Bags are available for pick-up in the "Worship Bag Wagon" following the children's sermon (or before if you would like) for those remaining in worship. These bags include a children's story Bible, coloring and activity pages about the day's scripture, and hands on resources for kids to keep their hands active while they participate in worship.

Play and Praise opens in room B201 following the children's sermon for children ages 3-Kindergarten. Parents may drop their children off and pick them up at the end of the service. Children this age are also always welcome to remain in worship if this is what's best for your family.

The **Prayground** is designed for elementary age children and is available for parents and children remaining in worship after the Children's Sermon. Parents must sit in the pews closest to the Prayground so they can assist their children throughout the service. Children may take their worship bags to the tables, and will also find quiet activities connected to the morning's scripture and themes. Worship Journals are available here to help children connect with different parts of the service. Engage your children in the flow of worship by having them join you in singing hymns and praying. There are bookmarks with The Lord's Prayer on them to mark key hymns or scripture. A volunteer "shepherd" will be present to help children and families as needed.

The **Nursery** is open in room A114 for children 2 and under.

Worship Leadership

Want to help lead worship? 3rd-5th graders can serve as Acolytes, lighting the candles each Sunday at the beginning of worship. Children may also serve as scripture readers or play in the chime choir. Contact jennie@pleasanthillpc.org to serve in any of these ways.
