Adapted from The Second Helvetic Confession

Q. 98. What is prayer?

**A. Prayer is an offering up of our desires unto God, for things agreeable to God's will, in the name of Christ, with confession of our sins, and thankful acknowledgment of God's mercies.**

Q. 99. What rule hath God given for our direction in prayer?

**A. The whole Word of God is of use to direct us in prayer; but the special rule of direction is that form of prayer which Christ taught his disciples, commonly called "the Lord's Prayer."**

Q. 107. What doth the conclusion of the Lord's Prayer teach us?

**A. The conclusion of the Lord's Prayer, which is, "For thins is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen," teacheth us to take our encouragement in prayer from God only, and in our prayers to praise God only, ascribing Kingdom, power, and glory to God only; and in testimony of our desire and assurance to be heard, we say, "Amen."**
