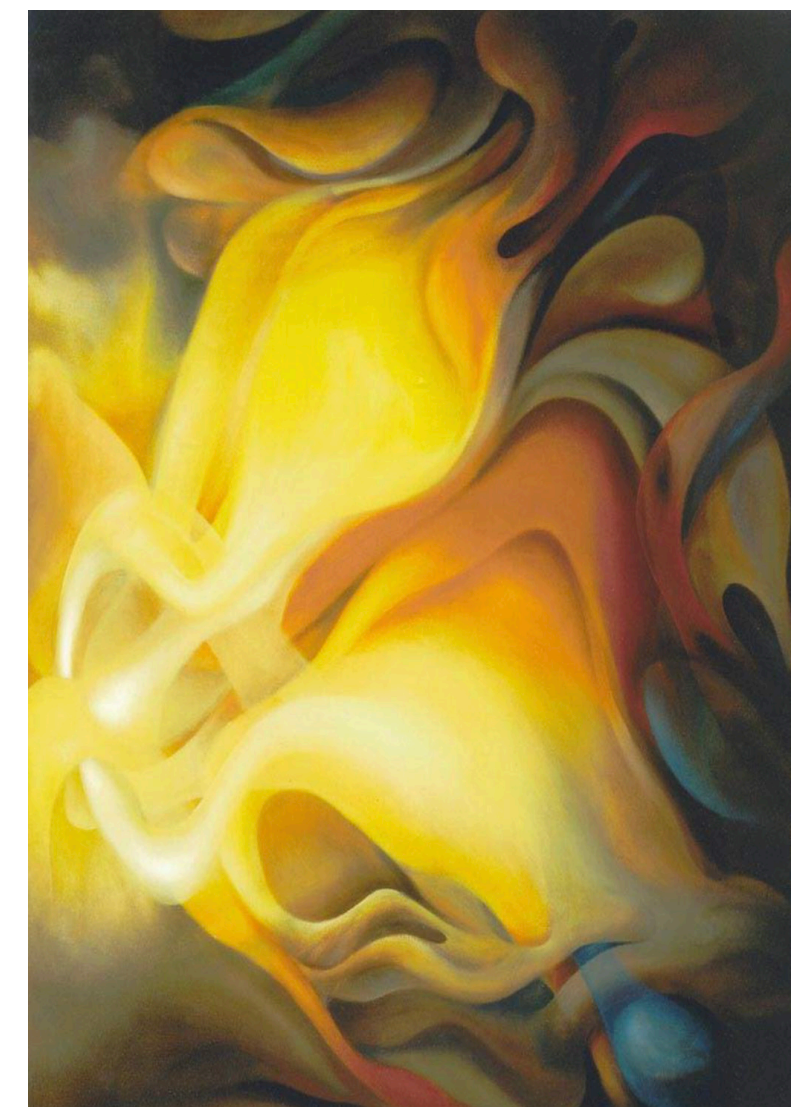

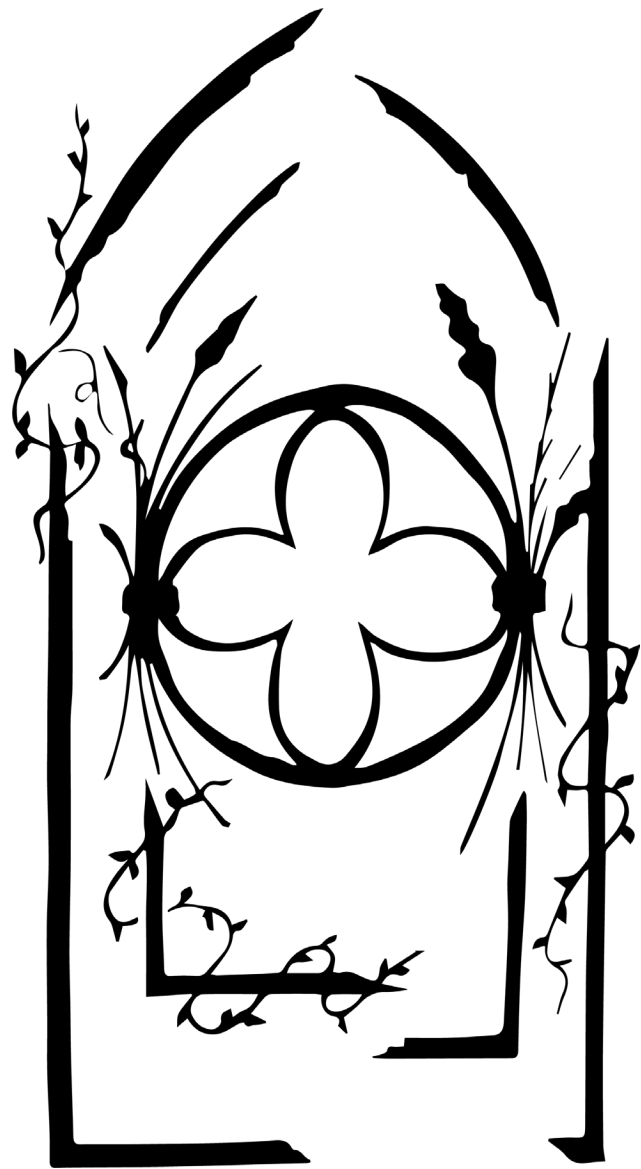
The Baptism
